- Band Program:
- Training band: This is a concert band for beginner musicians. This band has no prior musical experience required.
- Senior band: This group is for students that have been playing for at least 1 year.

Private music lessons

- The Music Partnership offers private music lessons at Bronte PS
- What is a private music lesson?
- A private music lesson is where students work one on one or in small groups with specialist teachers to build and develop skills on their chosen instrument.
- We offer lessons on:
- Flute, clarinet, saxophone, trumpet, French horn, trombone, baritone, bass guitar, acoustic guitar, piano and percussion.
- All students participating in our ensemble program are required to have a private or paired music lesson. You can take your lesson at school with us or you can seek external tuition. You must provide us with details of your external tutor.
- Private lessons run at school Monday-Friday from 3pm onwards subject to availability.

Opportunities to perform

- Each ensemble will have the opportunity to perform at various times throughout the year
- School Events: Assembly, Mid and end of year concerts, Mother's and Father's day breakfast, presentation day, school band workshop and school fete.

External events: NSW band festival.

Expectations and commitment

- Students are required to attend weekly rehearsals and to participate in their ensemble for a minimum of two terms
- All students are expected to respect the conductor and each other
- Please be punctual for rehearsals.
- Regular practice each day is also required to improve and learn new material. Practice is the key to enjoyment and improvement with any instrument.
- All students participating in our ensemble program are required to have a private or paired music lesson. You can take your lesson at school with us or you can seek external tuition. You must provide us with details of your external tutor.

Fees and costs

- Ensembles:
- Our ensembles are \$17.50+GST per weekly session
- Fees for ensembles are payable regardless of attendance.

- Private lessons:
- Individual lessons: \$45+GST per 30 minute lesson
- Paired lesson: \$30+GST per 30 minute lesson
